Event description	A hybrid event (physical and virtual) - Sustainable Places is a conference held every year dealing with all aspects of sustainability. The scope of Sustainable Places is captured directly in its name. It involves designing, building and retrofitting the places we live and work in a more sustainable way. Sustainable Places provides a platform for the dissemination of research, the conduct of workshops, EU project clustering and networking between stakeholders. SP2022 gathered 140 European projects representing somewhere between €500 million and €1 billion of R&D funding in sustainability.
